AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT

I, FAIZA SEIDU WUNI of chain homes estates, house number 7 plot 251, Accra, make oath and say as follows:

1. That I am the 2nd accused/Applicant and the Deponent herein, and I depose to facts contained in this affidavit in support which are within my personal knowledge and those I have been advised by Counsel and I verily believe to be true.
2. That I am currently standing trial before this Honourable Court and am also on a bail granted by this same Court, the conditions of which I have at all times complied with and have never defaulted or breached.
3. That the 1st accused person is my husband and has consented to the present application affecting the health concern of our son, Aludiba Hanan Sa-ad Wuni-mi, born on 10th November, 2018. A copy of his birth cert is attached herewith and marked as **Exhibit A**
4. That my son, was first diagnosed with social and emotional difficulties and executive functioning challenges as recorded in the individual education plan (IEP) issued by the Ghana International School on 10th September 2025. A copy of the individual educational plan is attached herewith and marked as **Exhibit B**
5. That following this diagnosis concerning my son's health, I sought a psychological assessment of my son from Mission Paediatrics on 13th July 2026, wherein, the attending clinician recommended a comprehensive assessment to evaluate his intellectual functioning together with a continued management of his attention- deficit/ hyperactivity disorder (ADHS). A copy of the assessment dated 13th July 2026 is attached herewith and marked as **Exhibit C**.

6. That pursuant to this recommendation in the preceding paragraph, I have through e-mail correspondence with the London psychiatry clinic through Dr. Lebens Tim secured an appointment for my son with Dr. Dahoun on 5th August 2026 at 2:00pm 60 Harley street, London, W1G 7H. Copies of the correspondence between myself and Dr Lebens, Tim are attached herewith and attached as **Exhibit D series**.
7. That it is in the best interest of my seven (7) year old son within the meaning and application of the Children's Act, 1998 (Act 560) as amended that, he receives the specialist medical attention abroad, and that as his mother, I am the most appropriate person to accompany him given the emotional and developmental support and attention he currently requires.
8. That according to Exhibit D series, there is likely going to be follow up appointments after 5th August, 2026 and as such, I will need the whole of August to finalize on my son's health concern. Since, the Court will soon be going on legal vacation and my trip is likely not to clash with any scheduled hearing date, granting me leave for the month of the August will not cause any undue delay in my trial.
9. That since my passport is being held by the Registry of this Court in satisfaction of the bail condition, I will not be able to travel out of the jurisdiction without the release of the passport and also leave granted by this Honourable Court.
10. That I am not a flight risk. I have at all material times in the trial complied with the bail conditions imposed by this Court and have never been absent from any Court sitting. I will also deposit my passport at the Registry of the Court on the date to be ordered by the Court if the application is granted.
11. That it is therefore in the best interest of the child and in the interest of justice that, this application be granted

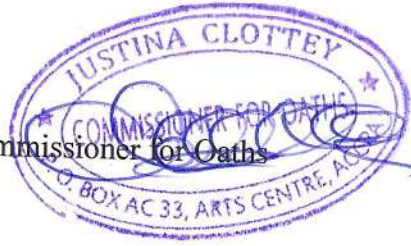

There have been more times than not, where Sa-ad has been a great member of the Year 2 class. However, there are still some inconsistent days where he is easily triggered, but he is still able to calm down with discussions and understanding of the situation. Overall, Sa-ad has really made strides in how much he has matured. The external therapy sessions are key to this and should be continued.

Summary and Referral for Educational Psychological Assessment

Sa-ad is a 7-year-old male first seen at Mission Pediatrics on 2 October 2024 with a diagnosis of Attention-Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder, Combined Presentation (ADHD-C; ICD-11: 6A05.2). A comprehensive psychoeducational assessment is recommended to better understand his cognitive and social-emotional profile and guide appropriate interventions.

Sa-ad was first seen due to concerns regarding impulsivity, a short attention span, disruptive behaviour at school, and emotional dysregulation. His diagnosis was confirmed through a clinical interview with Sa-ad and his mother, behavioural observation, developmental history, and the Behavior Assessment System for Children, Third Edition (BASC-3).

Developmental history was unremarkable. There were no pregnancy complications, he was born via Caesarean section, breastfed for one year and four months, and met all developmental milestones as expected. He currently attends Ghana International School, Accra.

Sa-ad has completed cognitive behavioural therapy focusing on emotional regulation, including psychoeducation on physiological cues to anger, deep breathing, progressive muscle relaxation, and the use of drawing (particularly sharks and planets, which are strong interests) as a calming strategy. He is currently prescribed Concerta® 18 mg daily, and his ADHD symptoms appear to be well managed.

Sa-ad has demonstrated a good memory, a high level of general knowledge, and a tendency to become frustrated or disengaged when tasks are insufficiently challenging, often describing them as "for babies." A comprehensive assessment is recommended to evaluate his intellectual functioning, identify his learning strengths and needs, and inform appropriate school-based and home-based interventions. Continued management of his ADHD is also recommended. Please do not hesitate to contact us should you require any additional information.
