We acknowledge receipt and accordingly submit the following responses to the information requested on the Member of Parliament for Sekondi's 2025 DACF allocations and disbursement from our records:

1. The total amount received – GH¢1,140,621.23.

The breakdown are as follows:

1 st Quarter	:	GH¢178,979.17
2 nd Quarter	:	GH¢331,744.41
3 rd Quarter	:	GH¢269,230.44
4 th Quarter	:	GH¢360,667.21

2. Disbursement as approved by the Hon. M.P:

a. Payment for free bus for SHS & JHS (Oct. 2025)	-	GH¢73,500.00
b. Payment for free bus for SHS & JHS (Nov. & Dec. 2025)	-	GH¢147,000.00
c. Payment for instruments/stage lightning and others/GRA	-	GH¢150,000.00

3. List of programmes and projects captured in the 2025 Annual Action Plan (AAP) for Sekondi:

Please note that the structure of the AAP is designed to capture many of the programmes and projects under "Metro wide", and not Sub Metro or Constituency specific. In order words, many of the interventions stated in the AAP are aimed to be implemented across the Metropolis. For the purpose of your request, we have provided some of the items listed for Sekondi. You may download the full document from the Assembly's website.

- a) Monitoring of Beneficiaries of Start Up Kits
- b) Organize training for 20 women on orange flesh sweet potatoes incorporation into diets
- c) Organize 2 trainings for technical staff on TEDMAG
- d) Restoration of historic sites and colonial buildings, Sekondi European town
- e) Facilitate the organization of "Yesu Asor "Easter Carnivals at Sekondi and Communities Fest at Adiembra, Kweikuma, Nkotoempo, Ekuasi/Essaman to boost domestic tourism
- f) Renovation of 5No. Basic Schools (Dr. Osam Pinanko, AME Zion JHS, Anoe D/A Primary School, Nassiriya Islamic Basic School, Kansaworodo Catholic Basic School)
- g) Organize Literacy Day Celebration
- h) Construction 2No. of CHPs Compound - Asamansudu, Ekuase,
- i) Redevelopment of Sekondi Rail Terminal into a mixed-use facility - Sekondi
- j) Construct 1No. Climate Smart Fish Smoking Facilities at European Town



4. Projects and programmes executed in Sekondi by the Assembly during the period:

It is important to note again that many of the programmes implemented during the period were targeted for Metro wide. The following are some specific programmes implemented in Sekondi during the period.

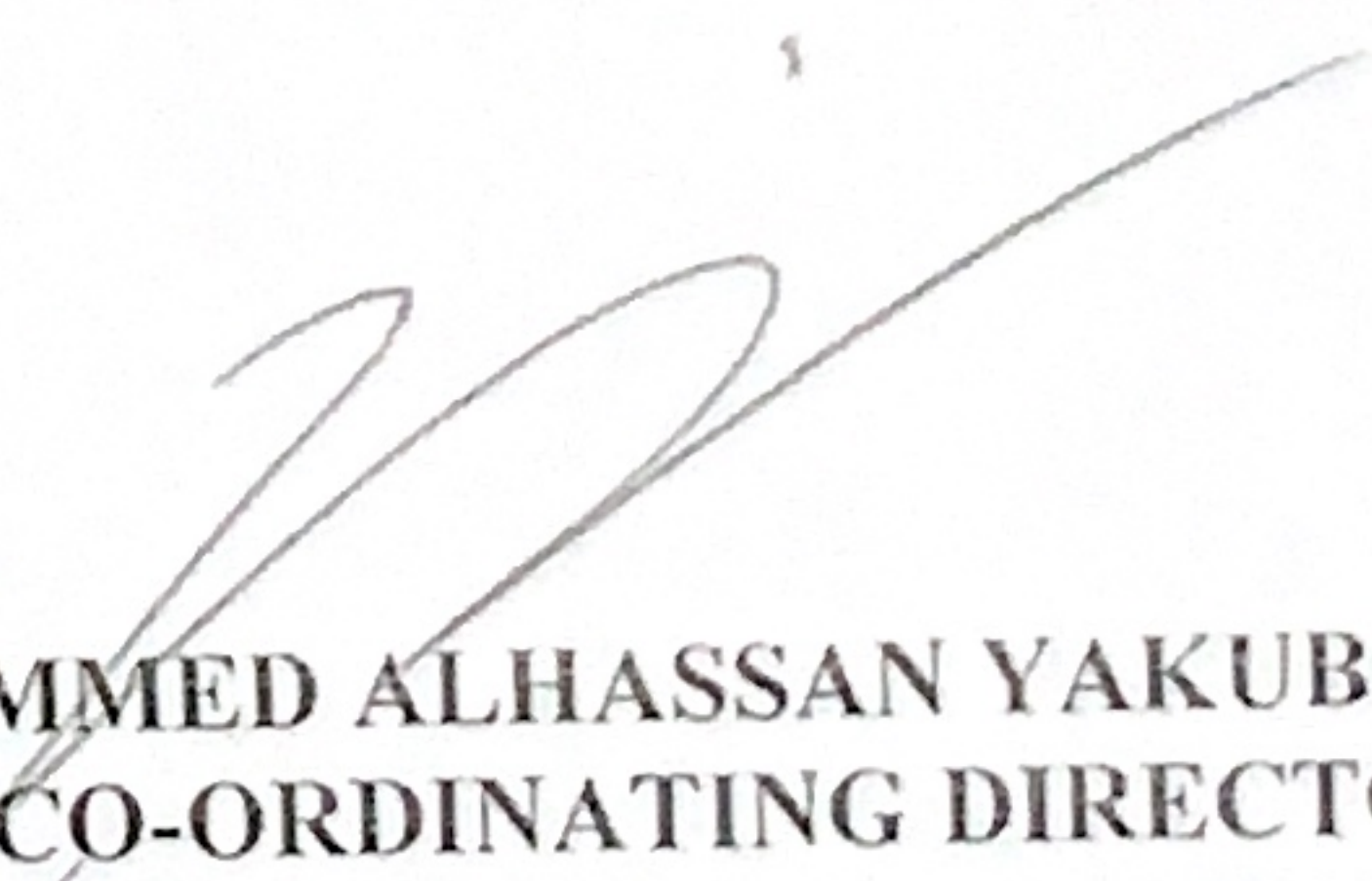
- a) Construction of six (6) unit classroom block with ancillary facilities at Nana Kobina Gyan Primary School, Adiembra
- b) Construction of 2-unit KG Block with office, store, kitchen and enclosed fencing at Model Nursery/ Primary School, Sekondi
- c) Construction of 6-seater water closet (wc) toilet facility with mechanized borehole at St. Annes Basic School, Bakaekyir
- d) Drilling and construction of mechanized boreholes with 10,000lts poly tank at Adiembra and Kweikuma
- e) Desilting of selected drains including Essei Lagoon, Boundary Road to Police Station Traffic Light, Egyinambowabakam Bridge to Nkotompo Dokodo (appx. 500m), Egyinambowabakam Bridge towards Bubbles (appx. 50m), and Adiembra Astro Turf
- f) Emergency road maintenance works at RCC roundabout (0.2km)
- g) Construction of 2 speed bumps
- h) Construction of pavement blocks road at Hosana Hills (0.11km)
- i) Gravelling of Abongo Biney Avenue, Nursery quarters (0.3km)
- j) Scarifying and reshaping of Yesua Street, Yensuado (0.12km)
- k) Approach filling works, Kweikuma
- l) 16 road sign installation works at speed bump locations

5. GETFund Allocations: We are unable to provide this information since the Assembly do not receive and disburse funds/allocations from GETFund.

6. National Health Fund: The information are as follows:

- a) The 2025 MP's Health Fund was received on 9th February, 2026.
- b) The total amount was GH¢250,000.00.
- c) The entire amount was used to purchase medical equipment including: delivery beds, hospital beds, electrocardiograph machine, drip stand, oxygen concentrators etc.
- d) The items were all issued to the Sekondi Zongo Health Centre.
