UPDATE ON INVESTIGATION INTO BUILDING COLLAPSE AT INDUSTRIAL AREA

1. The Accra Regional Police Command wishes to provide an update on investigations into the building collapse that occurred on 7th June 2026 at Avenue, opposite Melcom Plus, in the Industrial Area, Accra, which resulted in the death of three (3) persons and left another person seriously injured and currently receiving medical treatment.
2. As investigations continue, the Command wishes to inform the public that several relevant State institutions have been engaged to assist in establishing the cause of the building collapse. These institutions are conducting technical assessments to determine whether the incident resulted from structural defects or any other contributing factors.
3. The Accra Metropolitan Assembly (AMA), the Architectural and Engineering Services Limited (AESL), and other relevant agencies are collaborating to assess the structural integrity of the affected building and adjoining structures. These institutions will determine the appropriate measures to be taken, including whether any nearby buildings should be demolished or otherwise declared unsafe. Such determinations fall within the mandate of the relevant technical and regulatory authorities.
4. Meanwhile, Moro Badaru, who was arrested in connection with the incident on 13th June 2026, has been granted Police enquiry bail and is assisting with investigations.
5. The Accra Regional Police Command assures the public that investigations are ongoing and that any person found to have acted negligently or in violation of the law will be dealt with in accordance with the law. The Command further urges the public to remain calm and avoid speculation while investigations and the technical assessments are ongoing.
